Articulation Agreement Between Messenger College (MC) and Christ For The Nations Institute (CFNI)

Provisions Governing the Agreement:

- 1. CFNI students must meet MC's minimum academic & admissions requirements as stated in the most current catalog to be considered for admission to Messenger College.
- 2. Under Messenger College's current degree completion, CFNI graduates may transfer up to: 63 credit hours for a Bachelor of Arts in Counseling degree, 75 credit hours for a Bachelor of Arts in Christian Ministry degree, or
 - 39 credit hours for an Associate of Arts in Christian Ministry degree.
- 3. Course transfers will be reviewed and evaluated by the Academic Office based on the CFNI graduate's transcript and MC's current course requirements and credit transfer policy. Only courses with an earned grade of "C" or better will transfer. Remedial and developmental courses will not transfer.
- 4. Both program and institutional capstone courses must be completed at Messenger College.
- 5. Messenger College will provide to one Christ for the Nations Institute's staff or faculty member a full-time scholarship for tuition (up to 12 credit hours) and academic fees for one student per year until that student completes their degree. The student will be responsible for textbooks and any housing costs and fees. Once the degree is completed or the scholarship is terminated (see below), CFNI may nominate a consecutive recipient. To receive the scholarship, the student must be accepted to MC and a CFNI representative must send an email with the scholarship recipient's name by August 1st to the MC Registrar. If CFNI terminates the recipient's employment, they must notify MC within 30 days and the student's scholarship will terminate on the date of notification. The student must maintain consistent enrollment and a minimum of a 2.5 GPA to maintain the MC internal scholarship.

This articulation agreement will remain in force until either party gives thirty days written notice of intent to dissolve or amend the agreement.

All students may access any information about this agreement and/or federal regulations in accordance with Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools' (TRACS) standards on MC's website and in MC's publications, including the current Academic Catalog.
